

Dear CSOYO Symphony Members and Parents:

Here are all the details you need to know about our upcoming Spring Concert scheduled for Sunday and Monday, May 1-2, 2022 at Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Auditorium (SSMA). The Auditorium is located at 399 McCallie Avenue, Chattanooga, TN 37402. **Attendance is MANDATORY at all rehearsals and the concert.**

PLEASE NOTE: Parents or guests are not allowed backstage or inside Memorial Auditorium during rehearsals unless they are signed up to volunteer. Only volunteers will be allowed backstage at any time during rehearsals or the concert. Sign up to volunteer here: <https://signup.com/go/SMOZUvB>

CSOYO MEMBERS should stay in authorized areas of SSMA only – backstage areas and the stage - for safety and liability reasons. Please do not wander around in the building away from CSOYO areas for any reason. Thank you.

Sunday, May 1, 2022: 4:15 – 7:00 PM VENUE REHEARSAL SSMA

- 3:45 – 4:15 PM: Symphony members arrive to check in. Green CSOYO shirts suggested.
- **Enter through Backstage Door at the corner of Oak St. and Lindsey St.**
 - Pay Parking is available on the street or in nearby lots: <https://chattanoogaparking.org/>
 - After checking in, report to the Exhibit Hall to store personal belongings and instrument cases. Remain in this warm up area until you are called to the stage.
- 4:15 – 4:45 PM: Combined Symphony and Philharmonic Rehearsal
4:45 – 5:00 PM: Philharmonic Dismissed, Symphony resets
5:00 – 7:00 PM: Symphony Rehearsal with ensembles, concertos and Mr. Wilkes
7:00 PM: **Symphony Members will exit through the Backstage Door and should be picked up behind the building on Oak or Lindsay Street, NOT in the front on McCallie.**

Monday, May 2, 2022 4:15 PM Rehearsal, 5:00 PM Pictures, 7:00 PM CONCERT SSMA

FINAL REHEARSAL: Symphony members should arrive between 3:45 – 4:15 PM to check in. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLIER THAN 3:45 PM – you will not be admitted. Members should arrive fully dressed in CONCERT BLACK because group pictures will be made at the end of this rehearsal.** Enter through the Backstage Door, check-in, report to the Exhibit hall to store instrument cases and personal belongings. Be in your seat onstage for final rehearsal from 4:15 – 5:00 PM.

GROUP PICTURES: At 5:00 PM, the Symphony will move with instruments directly from the stage to the picture area for Group Pictures taken by Cansler Photography. These pictures will be made available for sale online following the concert and all YO Members will receive a link to the photo site. Once the Group Pictures are completed, all Symphony members will be released for dinner.

DINNER BREAK: Approximately 5:30 – 6:30 PM: YO Members may eat in the Exhibit Hall or exit the building through the Backstage Door. Dinner may be dropped off at the Backstage Door and delivered to YO Members by volunteers, or they can bring dinner with them. **All YO Members must be back in the Exhibit Hall by 6:30 PM.**

PERFORMANCE: Symphony Members will move together to sit as a group (not with friends or family) in the Auditorium prior to the start of the concert. They will remain in the audience until the Philharmonic performance begins, at which time they will move back to the Exhibit Hall for instruments.

REMINDER: All Symphony members must stay for the duration of the concert and remain with their orchestra. They may not come late or sit with family or friends during the concert.

AFTER THE CONCERT: Symphony Members will report back to the Exhibit Hall to collect their belongings. **ALL MUSIC SHOULD BE RETURNED TO THE COLLECTION BIN IN THE EXHIBIT HALL BEFORE DEPARTURE.** YO members can exit through the Backstage Door or through the Front Lobby at the end of the concert.

***An Archival recording of this performance is being made as a gift to the conductors by a CSOYO Alumnus. This recording will not be available for purchase, and the concert will NOT be livestreamed.

PARENTS:

1. **ABSOLUTELY NO VIDEO RECORDING** of this concert is allowed due to copyright law. We understand that you may have out of town relatives who are unable to attend the concert. However, copyright law only grants us permission for live performances of our music. The CSOYO and the CSO could be penalized if our concert is recorded and then posted on social media, Youtube or other public outlets, or rebroadcast live via streaming outlets without a license. Even recordings made for personal use are a violation. Please help us stay in compliance by enjoying the live performance and putting your phones and other recording devices away. Thank you.
